Just so you are familiar with the name Spero, incase you see it on your bank statements. Spero, Ltd is our legal business name and we are doing business as Northern Illinois Dance Center.

Tuition installments

We refer to our tuition as "installments" and not monthly tuition, as some months have a different number of classes than others. We take the total class cost for the session and divide it into equal installments. Example: a 60 minute class for the 25-26 year is \$620. It is then divided into 10 equal installments of \$62 due 8/15, 9/15, 10/15, 11/15, 12/15, 1/15, 2/15, 3/15, 4/15, & 5/15.

Auto Pay

All families must be enrolled in auto pay. You can pay by a different form of payment BEFORE the 14th of the month via the parent portal or in person. Otherwise, your card on file is charged on the 15th of the month.

Accepted forms of payment

Using our Jackrabbit <u>parent portal</u>, you must add a credit or debit card to your account. You can also choose to add a bank account. Or, you can pay via check, cash, credit in the studio **before** the 14th of the month.

Policies & Procedures

When you register, you are prompted to review and sign off on studio policies. This booklet lists those as well.

Late Fees

Tuition is due before the first day of your scheduled class. And installments are due by the 15th of each month. We extend a grace period until the 18th before we apply the late fee. The first month you are late, the late fee is 25% or your tuition installment. The 2nd month it will be 30%. It will keep going up in 5% incruments per month per session. If 30 days late, dancer can not attend classes till paid.

Dancers in multiple classes

Dancers who have back to back classes or are at the studio for extended periods of time

Dress accordingly! Dancers should NOT be making outfit changes. For example, if they have a hip hop class and then a ballet class - wear a leotard and tights for ballet, with shorts or leggings over it for hip hop. Hip hop shoes should be untied and ready in dance bag/cubby, so they can be put on quickly between classes.

- Snacks/meals: For dancers here for 2.5+ hours, it is OK to bring food but you MUST only eat in designated areas. Check with staff for area, as we are in the process of remodel. Clean up after yourself and be respectful of our home. There is a table to eat at (for dancers only). Dancers not cleaning up after themselves can have this privilege taken away.

Class curriculum

Every genre has curriculum and a syllabus for each level. This ensures accuracy, consistency, and quality dance education. The syllabus must be mastered by a dancer in order to move to the next level. Every dancer learns and progresses at a different pace. Each child has unique strengths. You can have the same group of dancers all start dancing at age 5, but by age 12 they have likely all progressed differently. As we always remind dancers....only compare yourself to the dancer YOU were yesterday.

The teacher of your child's class is the one to evaluate your dancer. When and if a dancer is ready to progress to the next level (for our leveled Jazz, Tap, and Ballet classes), you will receive written notice via email from the studio. Around spring break time classes with levels will receive progress reports/skill cards.

What should dancers bring

Dancers should bring everything in one bag. Be sure to come in outside shoes. Bring the appropriate shoes you will need for class.

Dancers should come in their dance attire, and only change at the studio when absolutely necessary.

Please make sure your dancer brings their water bottle. Spill proof is best especially for littles. Clear liquids only allowed in lobby and dance rooms.

Please leave all unnecessary items at home. Put your dancer's name in all dance shoes and on water bottles.

Dropping off & picking up

We ask that parents drop their child(ren) off in the lobby.

Level 1 (ages 7 & older) will be dismissed out the front. It is your responsiblity to be there to pick them up or have them stay inside to wait for you. Our Dance Basics & Combo classes (ages 7 & under) will be dismissed by staff members in the lobby. We do ask that you come in to get them. We like to see them with a parent before leaving. It is your responsiblity to be there before they are let out.

 We are no longer dismissing out back due to blocking the employees of our neighboring businesses.

Lobby Etiquette

Parents are welcome to wait in the lobby during class or choose to drop off/pick up. It's a great time to get errands done! There are plenty of staff around to help. Our lobby can get loud and congested as it is not very large, which makes for unfortunate distractions to our dancers/teachers in class. So please be mindful. Siblings waiting with parents should NOT be eating in the lobby, nor should they be running around unattended. This isn't an environment for kids to be playing and running around. Please wait in the car if this becomes difficult.

Movin' w/ My Mini parents will be in class with students. Creative Movement parents are invited to stay in the hall during the whole class time.



Winter weather cancellations

In the case of a cancellation due to weather, a push notification will be sent through our app. It will also be emailed & posted on our social media pages. No make-up classes will be held unless that same day of the week misses 3 or more.

Theme weeks & Special Events

It is very important to have our app downloaded and notifications on. Another reason for this is to remember our special events and theme weeks that we hold several times throughout the year.

All accounts must be paid in full to receive costumes, register for extra events, classes, privates, etc. No "extras" will be provided when accounts have a balance.

(a) Your Contact Info

Please make sure your mailing address, phone number, and email address are up to date in your parent portal. We send birthday cards, occasional texts, and sometimes leave surprises at homes.

Staff Portal

Lost & Found

Please label everything with your dancer's name on it. Even the inside of every dance shoe and on water bottles.

If you lose something, please check the lost and found. We do not keep items for more than a few weeks, as it can easily pile up. Please help us avoid extra clutter by claiming your items before they are donated.



Attendance & Abscences

We are very grateful to all who notify us via the app when your dancer will be missing class.

In our app you go to Parent Portal. Click on the 3 lines on top right corner. Then tap on Absences. You can then click on Submit an absence for your dancer when you know they will be missing. The reason is helpful to us as well. You can type that in there too.

*Elevation Dance Company members should reference their contract for absence policies

Make-up classes

Dancers are allowed 3 makeup classes, per class, per year. Classes must be made up within 2 weeks of the missed class. To attend a makeup class, please choose an age/level appropriate class. First email nidancecenter@gmail.com to make sure the class isn't full, and then check in at the front desk to sign in.

Photo Release


One of the policies you sign off on the parent portal when you register, is our Photo Release. This gives us permission to take photos of your child in class or at performances. These are used in promotional material such as our website, print, and/or social media. If you do not want your child in these photos, you MUST email

nidancecenter@gmail.com as well as remind the instructor on the first day so they have an additional verbal reminder as well, beside a note being in your dancer's profile.

Refund Policy & Dropping a Class

Students are not able to get a true feel for a dance class, after just one class. Always remember, it may take a few classes for them to warm up and feel comfortable – especially the younger ones. We require a 2 week written withdrawal form notice. Tuition will still be due for those 2 weeks. You can come to front desk or we can email you a copy of the drop form.

The student may continue classes during the 2 weeks the notice was given for. Not showing up to class or just discontinuing coming without notifying the studio, is NOT the same as providing written withdrawal notice. If you don't communicate with us, we do not know you need to discontinue. There are no refunds given on tuition payments that have already been made, in part or in whole. A refund will only be given if you have paid past the 2 weeks of the signed dropped form



Trust the process...embrace the jounrey!

Young dancers may have a hard time at first whether it's tears, tantrums, or lack of participation - it's all normal! Children learn best through consistency, and it will take at least a few weeks for some to adapt to a new activity.

Helpful tips and reminders for young dancers

Please make sure your dancer uses the restroom before class. This is a HUGE help for teachers and assistants.

Be sure and label all their items. We try our best to try and get them to put their dance shoes directly into their dance bags when we are changing shoes in class, but often shoes get misplaced.

Send a spill proof, easy for them to open water bottle.

First few weeks of classes

The first few weeks of classes, the studio will naturally be louder and more congested than usual during peak hours. We are a good size dance school with three dance rooms & 1 fitness room - it will take a few weeks for us to get in a good groove with letting dancers in and out of classes when there are multiple classes starting and ending at the same time. Please do not stand in the doorways of the classrooms.

We thank you for being patient and understanding! After a few weeks, everyone gets in a routine and more parents start to drop off so the lobby isn't as crowded.

If a teacher feels a student is not in the incorrect level, they will let office staff know and communication will come from the studio via phone or email.

Late Registration

If joining the session late, we will prorate tuition for that current tuition installment. However, the membership fee is not prorated and is only good for each school year. Recital participation depends on when you register and if we are able to still get a costume. We typically close off registration March 1. And even then you may not be able to participate. Email us to check.

Studio Conduct

Dancers are to be respectful to all teachers and classmates. It is very important to us that NIDC is a safe place for our members. We strive to make NIDC a home away from home for our dancers. We will not accept any disrespect or bullying. We do ask that if there are any issues and a member does not feel comfortable in class or studio, please bring it to Raelyn's attention. No cell phone usage in classes. No food or drinks (other than water) allowed in classes.

Termination of Enrollment

In certain circumstances, it may be necessary for the director to terminate a student's enrollment in the best interest of the student(s) involved. Every effort will be made to address and resolve any issues before resorting to termination. Reasons for termination of enrollment may include:

- Disruptive or dangerous behavior exhibited by students or their caregivers
- · Abuse of other children, staff, or property
- · Inability of NIDC to meet the child's needs

We prioritize maintaining a safe and conducive learning environment for all students, and termination of enrollment is only considered when it is deemed necessary and appropriate.

Medical Info

Does your child suffer from any medical conditions, disabilities or behavioral challenges we should know about? Be sure to indicate this in the parent portal under your child's profile.

Creative Movement

Clothes they can easily move in, preferred: leotard, tights, skirt (optional), hair pulled off face Shoes – Pink leather or canvas full sole Ballet Shoes *ones without ties.

Dance Basics

Leotard, tights, skirt (optional), hair pulled off face

Shoes – Pink leather or canvas full sole Ballet Shoes and Black Tap Shoes *both shoes without ties.

Ballet

All the gentleman dancers should wear a form fitting tank top and short with black ballet shoes.

Ladies - black leotard, pink tights, ballet skirt or fitted black shorts (optional), hair in bun

Shoes - pink leather or canvas ballet shoes.

Hip Hop

Comfortable clothing, hair pulled back, clean black sneaker. Shoes worn outside are not allowed as they track dirt & debris onto our dance floors.

Jazz

Leotard/tank/cami, fitted shorts/pants/leggings, hair pulled back, skin toned jazz shoe.

Lyrical

Leotard/tank/cami, fitted shorts/pants/leggings, hair pulled back, skin toned jazz shoe.

Combo Classes

Leotard, tights, skirt (optional), hair secured and pulled back

Color of shoes: Tap = girls & boys - black tap shoes,
Ballet = girls - pink leather or canvas full sole ballet
shoes * without ties, boys - black ballet shoes
*without ties, Jazz or Hip Hop = girls - skin toned jazz
shoes, boys - black jazz shoes

Styles needed:

Ballet / Tap Combo = will need both ballet & tap shoes

Musical Theater / Tap = will need jazz shoes and tap shoes

Recitals

Although rare, we understand families may have conflicts or other reasons they cannot participate in recital - dancers can absolutely participate in class even if they cannot be in recital.

Holiday Show Friday December 13, 2025 at 2pm held at Sycamore High School

Not all classes perform in the holiday show. Level 2 and higher may not perform. Check with your instructor if you are not sure. Holiday Show costumes are rented from the studio for a small fee. If you choose not to participate in the holiday show, we need to know by October 1st.

Recital Costumes

December Holiday Costumes are rented from the studio for \$15. This fee is due by November 1.

Spring Recital Costume Fees are due no later than January 1st. Spring recital costumes are ones you keep. The cost is on average \$80-\$100. It will depend on the costume that is picked for your class. Costumes fees are non-refundable. Costume balances not paid by January 5, will incur a \$20 late fee per costume. Anything after that could incur an additional cost to ensure that it is delivered on time.

NIDC Dancing in Technicolor

That is the theme of our end of the year recital. We hold 2 end of the year recitals. All dancers are in both shows. These are held at Sycamore High School on Friday June 5 at 6pm and Saturday June 6 at 1pm. Performing in both shows is required. Teachers and dancers both work hard on the routine and not having a dancer there can throw the routine and other dancers off. Costumes will need to be purchased for our spring recital. If not participating in June recital we need to know by January 1st.


